How to design inclusive cultural activities

To make your activity more inclusive, consider the following:

1. Inclusivity and diversity:

- Design activities for diverse age groups and cultures,
- Create a welcoming environment that encourages participation,
- Respect and value diversity.

2. Communication:

- Use clear, simple language in instructions and communication,
- Write key instructions in a shared document or whiteboard, so participants can easily follow them,
- Avoid offensive or exclusionary language or behaviour.

3. Accessibility and accommodation:

- Ensure platform and tool accessibility for all participants,
- Accommodate individual needs, such as closed captioning or sign language interpretation,
- Offer multiple material formats (audio, text, visuals) for participants with disabilities.

4. Tools and format:

- Provide user-friendly digital tools and alternatives as needed,
- Adjust the activity schedule and format based on participants' needs and abilities.
